QUARTET SISLEY

Quartet SISLEY is formed by Yuna Kadono (1st violin), Chiaki Katsuragawa (2nd violin), Maho Ikebe (Viola), and Yasunori Kato (Cello). In 2012, they started to perform as a quartet after performing at a concert "Classical Music loved by Taro Okamoto" (Taro Okamoto Museum of Art) to celebrate the centennial of the birthday of Taro Okamoto. The name "Quartet SISLEY" comes from a piece composed by Yasunori Kato, titled "String Quartet dedicated to Taro Okamoto TARO SISLEY – Dance, Pray, and Explosion". They have performed in this concert for four times in the past. Their first solo performance was held in 2013 at Shiodome Hall.

Quartet SISLEY have studied with Takumi Komoriya, Hiroyuki Matsuda, and L Déjardin at an open class for the masters of chamber music during ViolaSpace. In 2016, they participated in a joint recital at Gachon University in Korea and succeeded their first performance overseas. Next year, the first "Quartet SISLEY New Year Charity Concert" was hosted by ISSJ at Suginami Public Hall.

Notable collaborations for the Quartet SISLEY include performances with renowned soloists such as Sakurako Waseda, Takahiro Yamada, Takumi Komoriya, and Yasuko Ohtani. In 2018, Quartet SISLEY have earned good reputation at "First time Classics", a concert for children hosted by Artericca Shinyuri, and their performance for the next year has already been scheduled.
